


REPORTING VERB + ING form

admit advise deny recommend suggest

The doctor **ADVISED** watching my sleeping habits.

My son **DENIED** spoiling his sister's work of art.

My dad SUGGESTED going hiking in the mountains.





REPORTING VERB + OBJECT + PREPOSITION + ING form

accuse sb OF blame sb FOR compliment sb ON congratulate sb ON praise sb FOR remind sb ABOUT talk sb INTO thank sb FOR

Ania ACCUSED Alan OF pulling her hair.

Claudia TALKED Karen INTO playing hookie.

Ana THANKED her students FOR being so adorable.





REPORTING VERB + PREPOSITION + ING form

apologize FOR complain ABOUT insist ON object TO reflect ON

Brunico COMPLAINED ABOUT having to walk the dog.

The teacher INSISTED ON playing the song for the umpteenth time.

The students **OBJECTED TO** starting classes 30 minutes earlier.





REPORTING VERB + INFINITIVE

agree ask claim demand offer promise refuse threaten

My hubby **AGREED** to watch Peaky Blinders IN ENGLISH!

Alan PROMISED not to bug his sister again.

Ania THREATENED to tell mom if he did it again.





REPORTING VERB + OBJECT + INFINITIVE

ask advise encourage order persuade remind recommend

I ENCOURAGED my students to take part in the contest.

My friends **PERSUADED** me to go clubbing.

The teacher ADVISED her students not to procrastinate.





REPORTING VERB + (that) + CLAUSE

admit agree claim complain deny explain insist promise recommend repeat reveal say suggest think warn

My hubby COMPLAINED (that) I kept squeezing the toothpaste the wrong way.

My mom **EXPLAINED** (that) it was a healthy cake recipe.

The teacher REPEATED (that) everything she said would be on the exam.





REPORTING VERB + OBJECT + (that) + CLAUSE

assure convince inform promise reassure remind tell warn

My boss **ASSURED** me (that) I wouldn't have to do overtime.

My students CONVINCED me (that) we should put off the test.

I REMINDED my students (that) the deadline was in two days.
