## WILL

1. I don't think you **WILL HAVE** any problems when you land in London. (prediction)
2. Wait! I **WILL DRIVE** you to the station. (volunteering/spontaneous decision)
3. I promise I **WILL NOT** stay up late. (promise)

## PRESENT SIMPLE

1. The train **ARRIVES** at 4 o'clock. (timetable/schedule)
2. Hurry up! The film **STARTS** in five minutes. (timetable/schedule)

## BE GOING TO

1. Slow down! We **ARE GOING TO HAVE** an accident. (prediction BASED present evidence)
2. I **AM GOING TO STUDY** abroad. (plan/ intention)

## PRESENT CONTINUOUS

1. I **AM FLYING** to New York tomorrow afternoon. (arrangements)
2. I **AM SEEING** the dentist on Friday abroad. (arrangements)
