







- Are you going to the restaurant tomorrow night?




- 1.I don't think you WILL HAVE any problems when you land in London. (prediction)

- 3. I promise I WILL NOT stay up late .(promise)

PRESENT SIMPLE

- 1. The train ARRIVES at 4 o'clock. (timetable/schedule)
- 2. Hurry up! The film STARTS in five minutes. (timetable/schedule)

BE GOING TO

- 1. Slow down! We ARE GOING TO HAVE an accident. (prediction BASED present evidence)
- 2. I AM GOING TO STUDY abroad. (plan/intention)



PRESENT CONTINUOUS

1.I AM FLYING to New York tomorrow afternoon. (arrangements)

2. I AM SEEING the dentist on Friday abroad. (arrangements)
